What is Mosquito Barrier?

Mosquito Barrier is a concentrated garlic solution used to repel mosquitoes, as well as ticks, and small rodents. Mosquito Barrier does not kill mosquitoes, it simply repels them.

How do I apply Mosquito Barrier?

Handheld, backpack, quad, or truck sprayers can all be used to apply Mosquito Barrier.

When should I apply Mosquito Barrier?

It is best to apply in the evening. If rain is predicted within 24 to 48 hours, do not spray. Wait until the rain has passed, then spray afterwards. Mosquito Barrier will be okay through a few modest rain showers but will likely need re-application if heavy rains occur.

Do I have to spray my entire yard?

Not necessarily. Spray the areas that you and your family spend time in. This could include a deck, fire pit, walk path to the house, play area, etc.

How much solution is required for spraying?

With low mosquito activity and early in the season use 3% solution of Mosquito Barrier. For heavier infestations you may increase the strength anywhere from a 4% to 5% solution or more. Your best method would be to spray first with a 3% solution, if you still notice some infestation then increase the strength.

Does it smell bad?

It is a strong garlic scent, but don't worry; the smell goes away after a few hours!

What is the best spray pattern?

Start at your house or main base then work out. As you spray the Mosquito Barrier, you want to move the mosquitoes away from your premises, not trap them in. The objective is to treat mosquito adults' daytime resting sites, so work FROM the house.

Is Mosquito Barrier safe for children and pets?

Yes. Mosquito barrier is 100% pure garlic solution with some (0.7%) food grade preservatives. Do not spray directly on your pets. Instead, spray liberally on grass, shrubs, plants, sides of buildings, fence posts, etc. If there is heavy infestation, repeat in 5 days and then every 2 weeks thereafter. **DO NOT USE MOSQUITO BARRIER IF YOU/SOMEONE YOU KNOW HAS A GARLIC ALLERGY.**

Will Mosquito Barrier help keep ticks off my animals?

Yes. Mix a solution of 5-6% Mosquito Barrier and water. Spray the bottom half of your animal (horse, cow, and other grazers). This includes the tail, belly and legs.

Will my horses be able to eat the grass sprayed with Mosquito Barrier?

Yes. Garlic does not bother horses. Some horse owners actually feed garlic (in liquid and solid forms) to their horses.

How many acres can I cover?

0.946 L Jug = Approx. $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre
3.79 L Jug = Approx. 3 acres

Is Mosquito Barrier harmful to birds, bees, ladybugs or butterflies?

No, not at all. Birds, bees, ladybugs and butterflies are not bothered by the garlic spray. It is best to avoid insect stress by not spraying it on them directly.

What results should I expect from using Mosquito Barrier?

A good spray job will suppress the mosquito populations well but may not be 100% elimination. This suppression will reduce some disease risk but not all. It will take effect almost immediately and can last up to a month.

If I don't use the entire container of Mosquito Barrier, will it stay good until next year?

Put the lid on tight, store it in a cool place and it will last for about two years. In a refrigerator at 4 degrees Celsius, it will last several years. Do not let it freeze. Do not store in direct sunlight.
